


Why this training?

Parasite lifecycle

- Round worms
- Strongyles
- Barberpole





Florida's Hot & Humid environment


- Year-round parasite issues
- Attempt to control, not eliminate


Causes of parasite resistance:

- Frequent use
- Whole flock
- Calendar-based
- Treat and move to clean pasture
- Rotating dewormers
- Using injectable or pour-ons
- Continuing to use a 100% resistant product
- Underdosing

Refugia

- Targeted Selective Treatment
- Only administer dewormers to "those who would benefit most"
- "Refugia" are the worms who have not been exposed to products
- Also, identify animals that need to be culled





Estimating body weight

When using a combination treatment:

- Don't mix the wormers together give sequentially
- Use the 5-point check
- Give a full dose of each dewormer

The 5-Point Check

Use appraisal to determine treatment

Slow-down and eliminate parasite resistance

Are they showing signs that the parasites are affecting health?






#2 JAW

Edema Treat even if FAMACHA score is "good"





#4 TAIL

Scours Fecal Soiling



#5 Hair Coat

Should be even, full, & lustrous



Grazers vs. Browsers

- Cattle (and sheep) are grazers pasture grass
- Goats are browsers (and grazers) variety
- Most "infective" stage of parasites < 2 inches



Rotational grazing and/or grazing plan

- 3-4 days for egg development & 2 months for pasture to be free of parasites
- Therefore, move every 3 days and don't return for 2 months
- Or, have a minimum grazing height
- Plant annuals with some height
- Compost manure before spreading
- Night penning



Sunn Hemp

•Annual

•Legume


- •Alkaloids inhibit parasites
- •Prefers well-drained/dry soil
- •Begin grazing at 1.5-3 feet tall
- •Graze down to 1 foot
- •Limit graze 1-3 hours per day


Keep it off the ground!



Fecal Egg Counts

Labs charge minimal feePurchase equipment yourself?







Not just for disease!
Drylot
During quarantine, deworm with multiple products
Fecal egg count on day 7-14

Genetic Selection

Resistance

Resilience

Ability of the goat to reduce # of parasites

Ability of the goat to tolerate parasites Can have a high FEC

Moderately heritable trait at 20-40%
